

**NAHAS SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION MAILED
TO ALAMEDA COUNTY SCHOOLS**

Information on the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum Foundation's Robert T. Nahas Scholarships will be mailed to counselors at Alameda County's public and private high schools.

The four scholarships, to be awarded to two female and two male graduating seniors, are for \$2,750 a year to a maximum of \$11,000. Students must stay in good academic standing and progress towards obtaining a baccalaureate degree to continue to receive the award.

Criteria for the scholarships, named for Coliseum President Emeritus Robert T. Nahas, includes a minimum 3.0 grade point average, two years of community service and two years involvement in a competitive sports program.
