

**INFORMATION ON ANN & JON REYNOLDS SCHOLARSHIPS
MAILED TO ALAMEDA COUNTY HIGH SCHOOLS**

Applications and criteria for the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum Foundation's two Reynolds scholarships will be mailed to counselors at public and private high schools in Alameda County. The scholarships, named for former Coliseum Board Member/current Coliseum Foundation Board Member Jon Reynolds and his wife Ann, are for \$3,000 a year to a maximum of \$12,000 within a five-year period. They will be awarded to graduating seniors from Alameda County. Criteria include a 3.0 grade point average, two years of community service and a need for financial aid. Each awardee must stay in good academic standing and progress towards obtaining a baccalaureate degree to continue to receive the award.

The Coliseum Foundation also oversees the Robert T. Nahas scholarships and the George P. Scotlan scholarships. Anyone wishing to make a tax deductible contribution should mail it to the Coliseum Foundation at 7000 Coliseum Way, Oakland, CA 94621.
