

**INFORMATION ON GEORGE P. SCOTLAN SCHOLARSHIPS  
MAILED TO ALAMEDA COUNTY HIGH SCHOOLS**

Applications and criteria for the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum Foundation's three Scotlan scholarships will be mailed to counselors at public and private high schools in Alameda County.

The scholarships, named for former Coliseum Board member and youth benefactor George P. Scotlan, are for \$3,000 a year to a maximum of \$12,000 within a five-year period. They will be awarded to graduating seniors from Alameda County. Criteria include a 3.0 grade point average, two years of community service and a need for financial aid. Each awardee must stay in good academic standing and progress towards obtaining a baccalaureate degree to continue to receive the award.

The Coliseum Foundation also oversees the Robert T. Nahas Scholarships and the Ann & Jon Reynolds Scholarships. Anyone wishing to make a tax-deductible contribution should mail it to the Coliseum Foundation at 7000 Coliseum Way, Oakland, CA 94621.
